Checklist of Purposes to Meet Required Early Head Start Pregnancy Topics

This checklist is meant to provide a quick reference tool to Early Head Start home visiting staff searching for *Partners* curriculum content to meet **HSPPS 1302.81**.

HSPPS 1302.81(a) includes: "providing prenatal and postpartum information, education and services that address, as appropriate, fetal development, the importance of nutrition, the risks of alcohol, drugs, and smoking, labor and delivery, postpartum recovery, parental depression, infant care and safe sleep practices, and the benefits of breastfeeding."

The Partners curriculum contains a wide array of content to address HSPPS 1302.80(d) and 1302.81(b):

"At a minimum, the [newborn] visit must include a discussion of the following: maternal mental and physical health, safe sleep, infant health, and support for basic needs.

"A program must also address needs for appropriate supports for <u>social and emotional well-being</u>, <u>nurturing and responsive caregiving</u>, <u>and father</u>, <u>partner</u>, <u>or other family member engagement</u> during pregnancy and early childhood."
